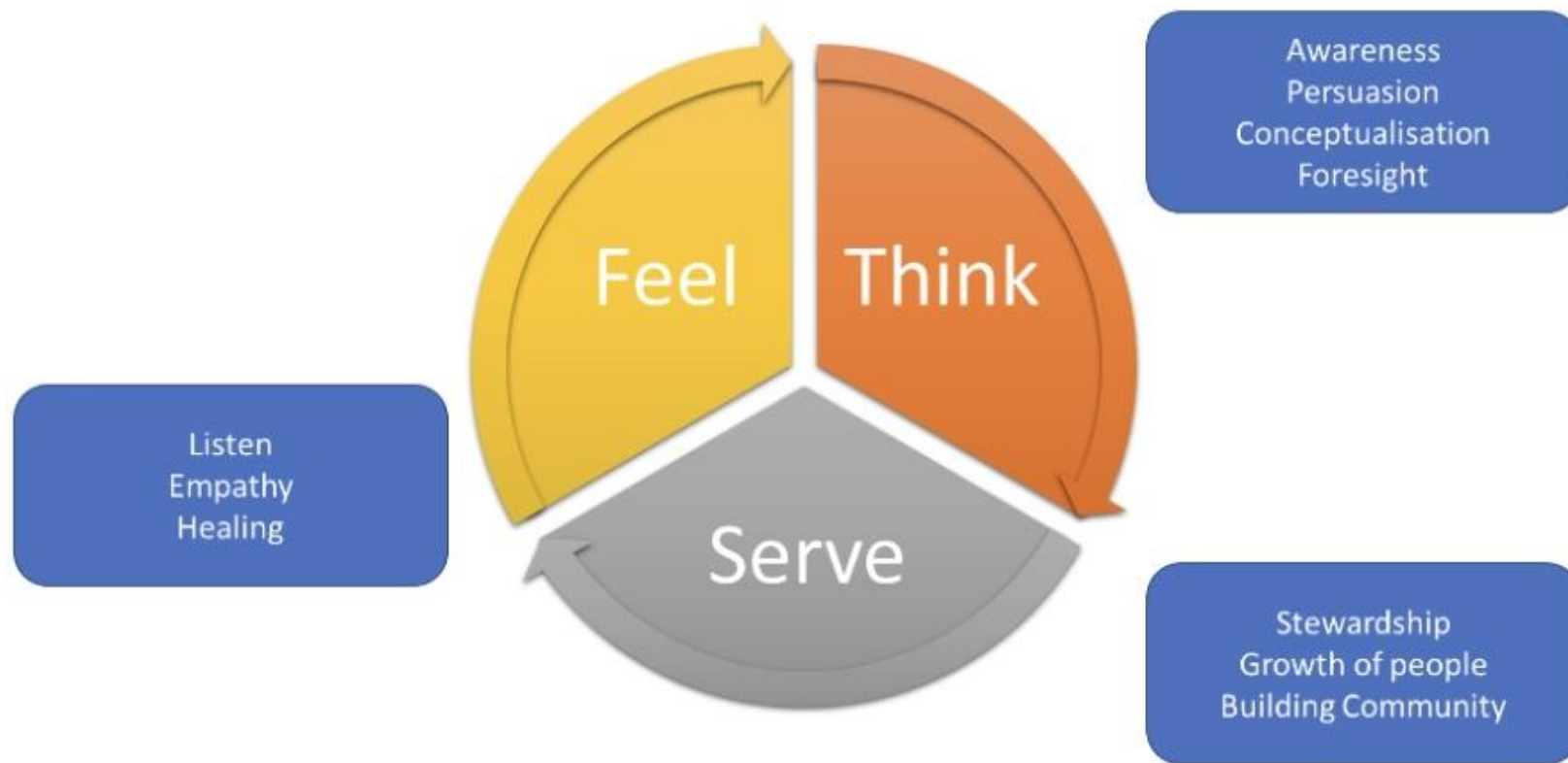

# INTRODUCTION TO DSA

The Direct School Admission for Secondary Schools (DSA-Sec), introduced in 2004, allows students to seek admission to a secondary school on the basis of a diverse range of academic and non-academic talents and achievements that may not be demonstrated at the Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE).

Schools offer talent development programmes in the following categories:

- Languages and Humanities
- Leadership and Uniformed Group
- Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM)
- Sports and Games
- Visual, Literary and Performing Arts

If your child is admitted to a secondary school through DSA-Sec, they are not allowed to:

- Submit school choices during the Secondary 1 (S1) posting process.
- Transfer to another school. They must commit to their chosen school for the duration of the programme.

**Note:** Participation in the DSA-Sec is optional.



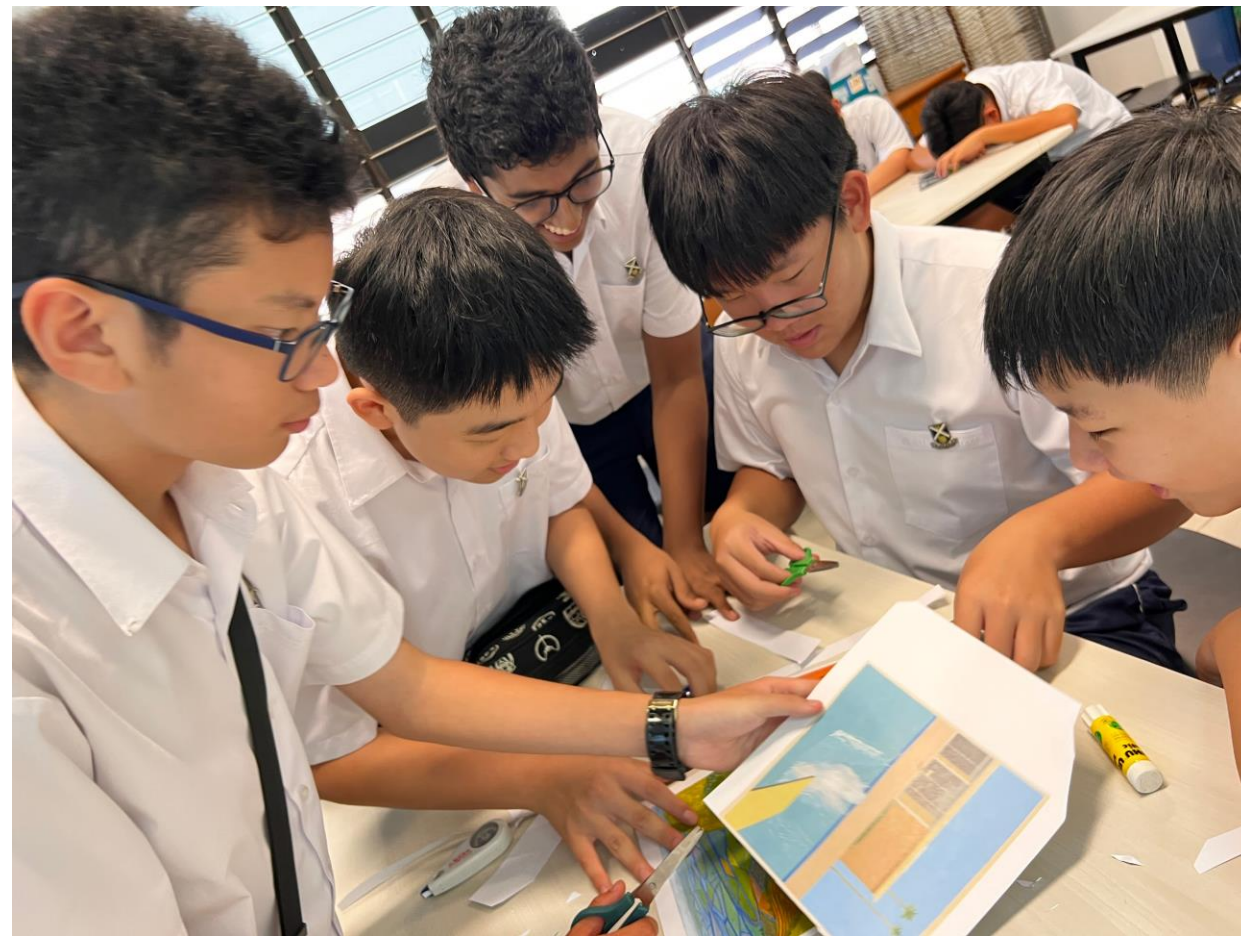

# ADMISSION CRITERIA

The DSA-Sec exercise is for **male Primary 6 Singaporean, Singapore PR and International students** who have outstanding talent in Student Leadership, Concert Band, Hockey, Rugby, Water Polo & Visual Arts.

Note: Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee the student will be shortlisted / given an offer.





# SELECTION PROCESS FOR DSA

## STAGE 1

### **Talent-Area Specific**

- 1) Physical Selection Trials
- 2) Auditions

## STAGE 2

### **Interview**

Face to face

## STAGE 3

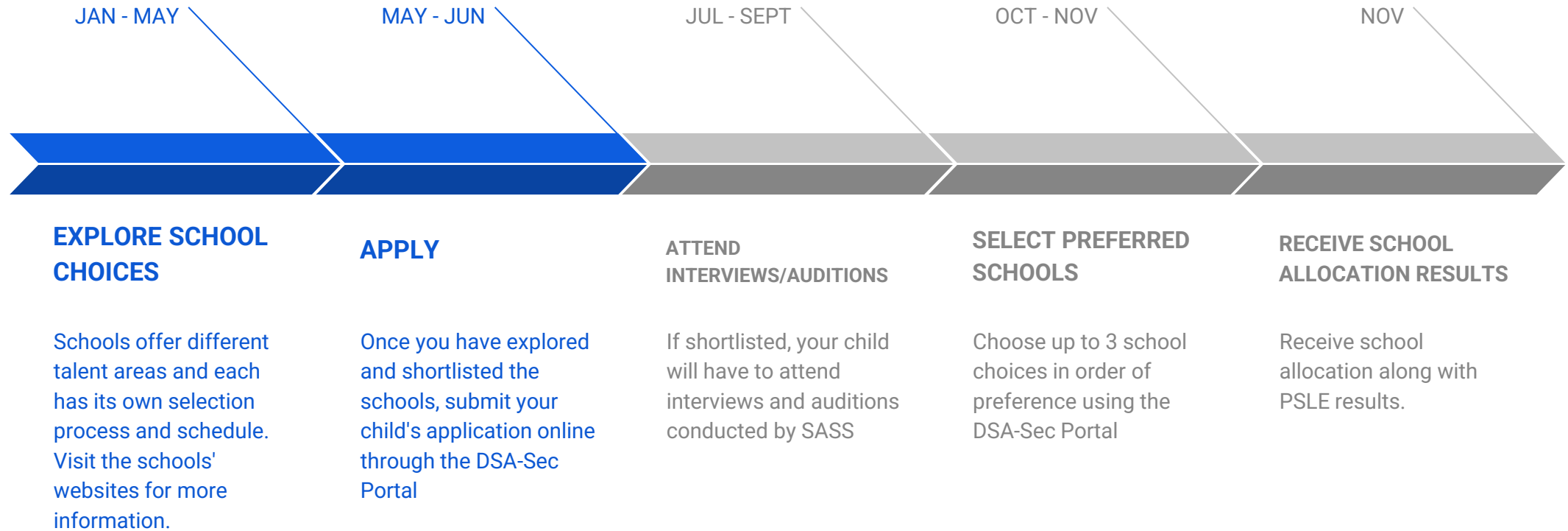
### **Issuance of**

1. Confirmed Offer (CO),
2. Wait List (WL) or
3. Unsuccessful notifications (R) to all applicants.

Note: Please note that the school is unable to entertain any appeals



# DSA TIMELINE



- Records in the MOE DSA-Sec Portal to be considered for selection includes national age group rankings and/or results from national inter-primary school competitions and/or results from other competitions sanctioned by the respective National Sports Associations or relevant competition organisers. Physical fitness test results, experience, qualifications and participation in the Co-curricular Activities (CCAs) will also be considered.
