INTRODUCTION TO DSA

The Direct School Admission for Secondary Schools (DSA-Sec), introduced in 2004, allows students to seek admission to a secondary school on the basis of a diverse range of academic and non-academic talents and achievements that may not be demonstrated at the Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE).

Schools offer talent development programmes in the following categories:

- Languages and Humanities
- Leadership and Uniformed Group
- Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM)
- Sports and Games
- Visual, Literary and Performing Arts

If your child is admitted to a secondary school through DSA-Sec, they are not allowed to:

- Submit school choices during the Secondary 1 (S1) posting process.
- Transfer to another school. They must commit to their chosen school for the duration of the programme.

Note: Participation in the DSA-Sec is optional.



DSA TIMELINE

JAN - MAY - JUN JUL - SEPT OCT - NOV NOV

EXPLORE SCHOOL CHOICES

Schools offer different talent areas and each has its own selection process and schedule. Visit the schools' websites for more information.

APPLY

Once you have explored and shortlisted the schools, submit your child's application online through the DSA-Sec Portal

ATTEND INTERVIEWS/AUDITIONS

If shortlisted, your child will have to attend interviews and auditions conducted by SASS

SELECT PREFERRED SCHOOLS

Choose up to 3 school choices in order of preference using the DSA-Sec Portal

RECEIVE SCHOOL ALLOCATION RESULTS

Receive school allocation along with PSLE results.

• Records in the MOE DSA-Sec Portal to be considered for selection includes national age group rankings and/or results from national inter-primary school competitions and/or results from other competitions sanctioned by the respective National Sports Associations or relevant competition organisers. Physical fitness test results, experience, qualifications and participation in the Co-curricular Activities (CCAs) will also be considered.
