

ADMISSION & SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1. The DSA-Sec exercise is for male Primary 6 Singaporean, Singapore PR and International students who have outstanding talent in Concert Band, Hockey, Rugby, Tennis, Waterpolo, STEM and Visual Arts.
- 2. Selection Criteria for students will be selected based on the following:
 - Primary 5 and 6 academic results or equivalent results from 2022 and 2023.
 - Talents in the following areas: Concert Band, Hockey, Rugby, Tennis, Waterpolo, STEM & Visual Arts.
 - Records in the MOE DSA-Sec Portal to be considered for selection includes national age group rankings and/or results from national inter-primary school competitions and/or results from other competitions sanctioned by the respective National Sports Associations or relevant competition organisers. Physical fitness test results, experience, qualifications and participation in the Co-curricular Activities (CCAs) will also be considered.
 - There is no need for applicants to contact our teachers. After 26th June 2023, our teachers will contact the applicants for talent selection trials, interviews or auditions, where applicable.
 - Meeting all the criteria does not guarantee the student will be shortlisted / given an offer.
- 3. Application for DSA-Sec can be submitted through the online DSA-Sec Portal. The application is free-of- charge and will be open from 4 May 2023, 11am to 31 May 2023, 3pm. For more details, please refer to MOE website www.moe.gov.sg/dsa-sec.
- 4. Parents and students are encouraged to choose schools wisely based on the student's aptitudes and strengths, bearing in mind the schools' academic and non-academic requirements, and the programmes available to develop the area of talent.
- 5. Students who are successfully admitted to the school via DSA are expected to honour their commitment to the school, and participate in the activities related to the talent they are selected for from year 1-4.

STEM	Students will be requested to exhibit their basic programming knowledge, fundamental circuit creation abilities, and general STEM knowledge.	Successful applicants be given Robotics as to CCA, with the opportunt to represent the school related inter-school competitions.

<u>FAQs</u>

1. What is Direct School Admission (DSA)?

Direct School Admission (DSA) gives schools flexibility in selecting students in the talent areas as specified by the individual schools. This also allows Primary 6 students to be recognised for a more diverse range of achievements and talents.

- 2. Is there an admission quota for DSA in St. Andrew's Secondary?
- St. Andrew's Secondary admits up to 20% of our Secondary 1 students via DSA.
- 3. How much flexibility is given to St. Andrew's Secondary in terms of choosing students?

 Schools can decide on their own admission criteria. However, primary school students must achieve PSLE results that would enable them to be eligible for admission to the course being offered by the school.
- 4. Can I apply to St. Andrew's Secondary through another CCA not listed in the school's talent areas? No. Applicants may only apply through the talent areas listed.
- 5. Must I still sit for PSLE if I have received a Confirmed Offer (CO) for St. Andrew's Secondary? Yes, students must sit for the PSLE, even though they have received a Confirmed Offer (CO) from St. Andrew's Secondary.
- 6. Can a student below Primary 6 apply for DSA?No, admission to Secondary 1 is only for Primary 6 students or its equivalent.
- 7. Can I still opt for St. Andrew's Secondary in the Posting Exercise if I do not make it through the selection rounds? Yes, you can still choose St. Andrew's Secondary in the Centralised Posting Exercise, after you have received your PSLE results. However, this admission will be solely based on your PSLE results and the availability of places in the school.
- 8. Can I apply for more than one talent area?

Yes. St. Andrew's Secondary allows you to apply to more than one talent area, but you will only be chosen for ONE program. For instance, if you apply for DSA through both rugby and hockey and you are successful, you will only get a Confirmed Offer based on either rugby or hockey.

9. How does St. Andrew's Secondary select the students?

Face-to-face Trials will be conducted by the respective CCA Teacher-in-Charge and coaches/instructors. There will also be an interview conducted with the CCA Teacher-in-Charge, selected key personnel, and school leaders.

10. When will I be notified of the trials and interviews?

The respective CCA Teachers-in-Charge will inform you of the details via email.

11. Will I receive a notification if I am not shortlisted for the trial and/or interview?

You will not receive a notification if you are not shortlisted for the trial and/or interview.

12. When will I know if I have been selected?

The outcome of DSA applications (successful or unsuccessful) will be released by late Nov.

13. Do I still have to take part in the MOE Posting Exercise if I am selected by St. Andrew's Secondary?

Students successfully allocated to their DSA-Sec schools will **NOT** be allowed to participate in the annual Sec 1 Posting Exercise to opt for secondary schools and are expected to honour their commitment to the allocated DSA-Sec school for the entire duration of the program. They will also NOT be allowed to transfer to another school after the release of the PSLE results.
