1. KEY EVENTS IN TERM 4

1.1 <u>School-based Assessments</u>

The following school-based assessments will be held in Term 4:

- a) English Language Listening Comprehension will take place on 26 Sep, Tues from 3.30 pm to 4.15 pm, for students of the Secondary 3 Express and NA (Out-of-stream) course.
- b) English Language Listening Comprehension will take place on 26 Sep, Tues from 2.30 pm to 3.15 pm, for students of the Secondary 3 Normal Academic course.
- c) The End-of-Year Examination for Secondary 1 to 3 students will take place from 27 Sep, Wed, to 10 Oct, Tues.
- d) The MTL school-based oral examination for Sec 3 students (all TGs) will be conducted in Term 4 Week 2 and Week 3 (18-19 Sep, 21-22 Sep and 25 Sep). Students will be notified of their schedule by Term 4 Week 1. Please refer to the instructions given by the respective TG MTL teachers for more information.

1.2 National Examinations

Secondary 4 and 5 students will sit for the following national examinations:

a) GCE 'N' Level Examination from: Phase 1: 12 Sep, Tues to 21 Sep, Thurs Phase 2: 2 Oct, Mon to 10 Oct, Tues

- b) GCE 'O' Level Science Practical Assessment on 4 Oct, Wed, 9 Oct, Mon, 12 Oct, Thurs and 17 Oct, Tues.
- c) GCE 'O' Level Examination from 10 Oct, Mon to 10 Nov, Fri.

1.3 <u>Structured Remedial and Study Programmes</u>

To prepare students for the upcoming school-based and national examinations, the following programmes will be conducted:

- a) Structured Remedial Programmes for Graduating students from Term 4, Week 1.
- b) Intensive Revision for Secondary 4NA and 4NT students (Phase 2) from 25 Sep, Mon to 29 Sep, Fri.
- c) Intensive Revision for Secondary 4 Express and 5NA students will be held from 18 Sep, Mon to 29 Sep, Fri.
- d) Please note that the **commencement ceremony** to honor all our graduating students, will take place on the **29 Sep, Fri at 11.00am** and students are expected to be fully attired in the school shirt, pants and tie.

1.4 Replacement of TGIF days in Term 4

Please take note that we will <u>not</u> have any TGIF (Tech Goodness It's Friday) days in Term 4. Students will report to school for lessons as usual on all Fridays. School will end at 12.30 for all students.

1.5 Marking Day (11 Oct, Wed)

Students will not need to report to school on 11 Oct, Wed, which is set aside for teachers to complete the marking of the end-of-year examination papers.

1.6 Promotion Exercise (24 Oct, Tues)

The promotion exercise will be held on 24 Oct, Tues. Students will not need to report to school on that day.

1.7 <u>Confirmation of Course Options for Secondary 2 Students (16 Oct, Mon to 22 Oct, Sun)</u> All Secondary 2 students are required to confirm their Secondary 3 course options from 16 Oct, Mon to 22 Oct, Sun. The results of course allocation will be released by 1 Nov, Wed, 1700 hrs.

Appeals should be submitted by 3 Nov, Fri, 1400 hrs. The results of the appeal will be released by 8 Nov, Wed, 1700 hours.

Links to the forms for the Course Option exercise and appeal exercise will be provided closer to the date.

1.8 Cultural Arts Experience for Secondary 1 students (19 & 20 Oct)

Our Secondary 1 students will be participating in a series of hands-on Cultural Arts workshops on 19 and 20 Oct that aims to deepen their appreciation for other cultures through arts and nurture their confidence in performance. The boys will get to understand the various cultures through different art forms, such as traditional dance, music, shadow puppetry and poetry recital, and perform as a class at the end of each workshop.

1.9. <u>Learning Journey to Singapore Science Centre and Hike for Secondary 2 students (19 & 20 Oct)</u>

Our Secondary 2 students will be attending a one-day programme of their choice at the Singapore Science Centre on 19 Oct (Sec 2 WISE) and 20 Oct (Sec 2 TRUEm). The choice of workshop ranges from learning about the physics behind rocket science, food chemistry to forensic science and mathematics games for problem solving.

A consent form will be sent via Parents Gateway closer to date for students to indicate their preference and also for parents to endorse deduction from the Edusave account for the selected workshop.

Our students will also be participating in a hike around Singapore to foster deeper appreciation for nature and enjoy the greenery.

1.10. <u>Careers Exploration Day and Learning Journey to Singapore Science Centre/ Hike for</u> <u>Secondary 3 students (19 & 20 Oct)</u>

Careers Exploration Day for Secondary 3 students will take place on 19 Oct. Students will be given opportunities to hear from professionals from different industries. The speakers are from The Astronauts' Collective, a non-profit organisation that helps youths explore the world of work and find meaningful careers.

On 20 Oct, our Secondary 3 students will either be participating in a hike around Singapore to be at ease with and develop a deeper appreciation for nature or participate in UNTAME Schools 2023 organised by the Singapore Science Centre which will bring students on a journey to learn about the Revolution of Food.

 - b) Reflecting & Improving
 - 1) Think about the situation you are in.

- 2) Identify your behaviour and feelings.
- 3) Consider if your behaviour is appropriate for the situation.
- 4) Identify other behaviours that would be more helpful for the situation.
- c) Asking for help
 - 1) Look for someone who can help you.
 - 2) Check if the person has time to help.
 - 3) Describe the problem to the person. Be specific
 - 4) Listen if advice is given. Reflect on it.
 - 5) Thank the person sincerely.
